

At Hartlebury Castle, we have many stained glass windows in our Chapel, Lobby and Great Hall. Using this guide, you can create something similar for your own home! Use the template provided, or you can print/draw any image you like to make it completely your own!



You will need:

- A piece of clear plastic sheet or punched poly pockets
- Permanent markers (we recommend Sharpies)
- The design you want to use on a piece of paper
- Scissors
- Tape



Print off the design you want to use. If you are using punched poly pockets you can simply put the design inside to keep it secure. If not, just use tape so it doesn't slip.

Use your markers to trace the design on the plastic. Allow enough time to dry and cut out your window from the plastic. Using tape, you can now hang your creation up in a window where it can catch the sun.
