





How to Draw a Walrus/Seal in 5 Easy Steps!








Step 2. Add two curvy lines in a swooping motion to flesh out the tail, so it looks a bit like a ghost.



Step 3. Add two half moon shapes to the bottom curved line to make your walrus' front fins and a crescent moon shape at the thin end of the tail to make the back flipper.



Step 4. Start adding detail; use small circles for eyes and an upside down triangle for the nose, with a jagged semi-circle for his moustache and long thin triangles for tusks. You can also add a notch in the tail and small lines on the fins.

Step 5. Finishing touches: Outline the outer edge and erase your construction lines. Using small semi-circles around the eyes and mouth area make your walrus look like he's smiling. If you prefer a seal to a walrus, draw the eyes and nose the same, but instead of a moustache and tusks, draw a sideways number 3 and add whiskers.
