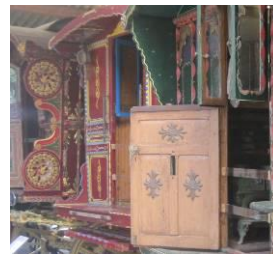


# Make your own Paper Gypsy Waggon

In Hartlebury Castle's Transport Gallery you can see an impressive range of traditional Gypsy waggons, also called vardoes. Now you can make your own paper waggon to display at home! You can also use card if you want your waggon to be a bit sturdier.



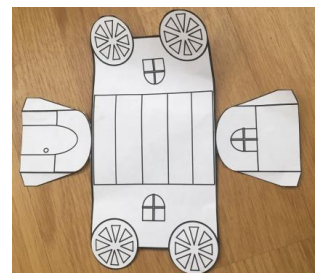
## You will need:

- A piece of A4 paper or card
- Colouring crayons or felt tips
- Glue or tape
- Scissors

Print the waggon template on the next page. Using your crayons or felt tips, colour it in. You can use the pictures from our Transport Gallery above for inspiration.

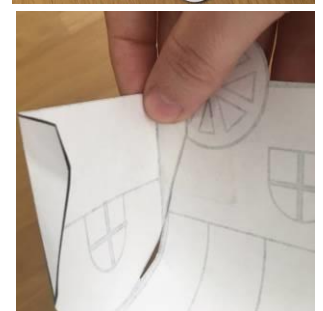


Carefully cut around the outside of the template. Take extra care where we've marked on the template and around the tabs – you don't want to accidentally cut these bits off! You should end up with a single piece that looks like the image on the right.



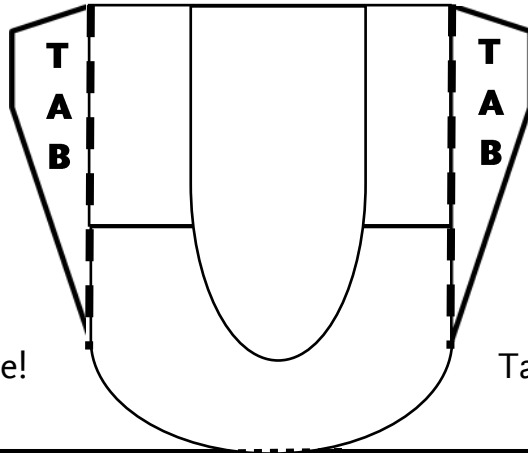
Fold the tabs along the dotted lines then fold down the front and back of the waggon.

Using tape or glue, stick the tabs to the inside of the waggon. The paper will naturally curve along the sides.



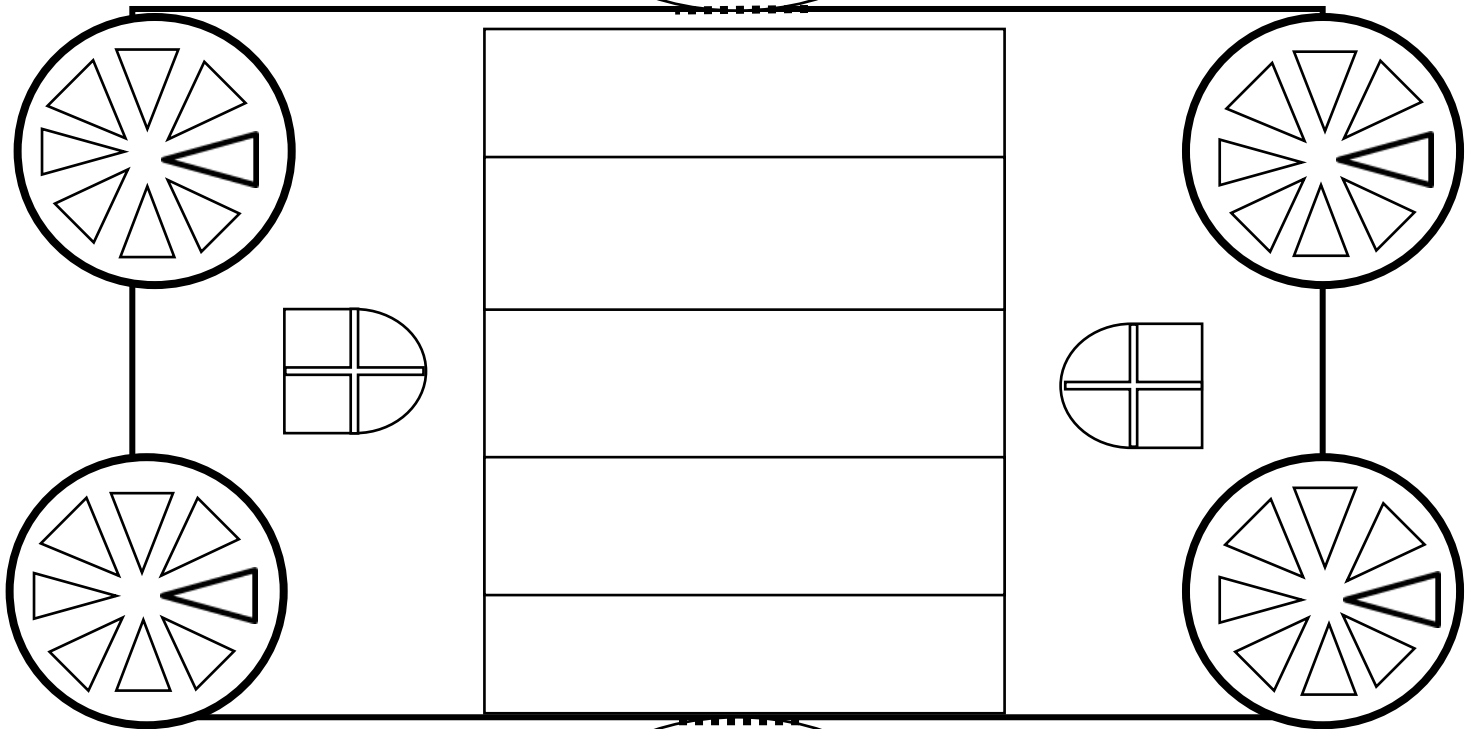
Voila! You now have your very own beautiful paper Gypsy Waggon! Feel free to print off more than one to create your own caravan of traditional waggons! (A caravan is the name for a group of waggons.)
