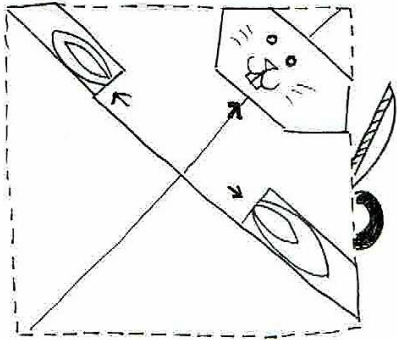
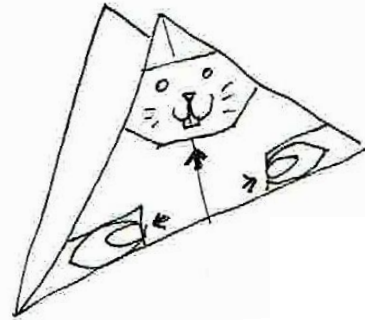


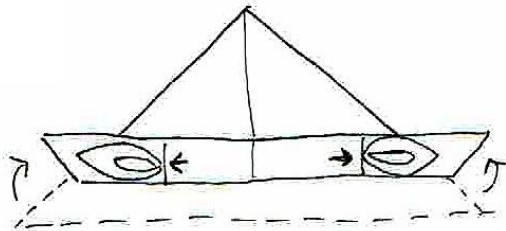
How to Pull a Rabbit Out of Paper: Instructions



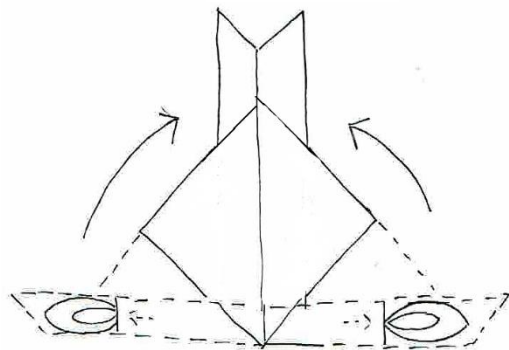
Step 1. Draw your rabbit's face and ears in the shapes provided, use the arrows to see which direction they will end up in. Carefully cut around the square.



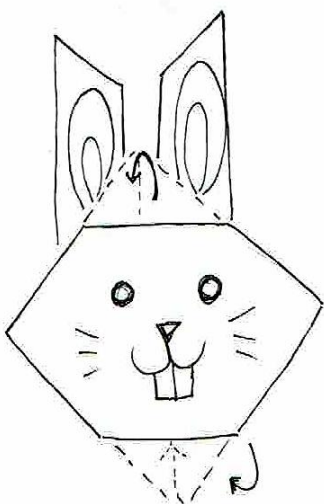
Step 2. Fold the square in half diagonally, following the line just underneath the space for the ears.



Step 3. Turn your paper over so that the face and ears are facing down, then fold the bottom section up so you can now see the ears. It should look like a sailboat!



Step 4. Slightly tricky part now! Fold both edges of the sailboat up to the centre line.



Step 5. Turn your paper over. You'll know you've done the previous step correctly if the ears and face are both facing you now. Final step now! Just fold over the top and bottom of the rabbit's face to give it a proper shape.

And hey presto! As if by magic, that's how you pull a rabbit out of paper!
