

Make a wonderful daffodil at home with things found around the house!

You will need:

- A piece of A4 card
- Green, yellow or orange felt tip/ crayon/ coloured pencil
- Paper egg carton
- Yellow or orange paint
- Paintbrush
- Scissors
- Glue or stapler
- A skewer

What to do:

1. Take your egg carton and carefully cut out the individual egg holders – this will make the trumpet of your daffodil.



Cut section of egg carton. – for extra decoration cut triangles into the trumpet.

2. Paint the 'trumpet' yellow or orange – allow to dry.
3. Paint the skewer green.
4. Print the pattern on to card.
5. Colour in the leaves using a green felt tip/ crayon/ colouring pencil.



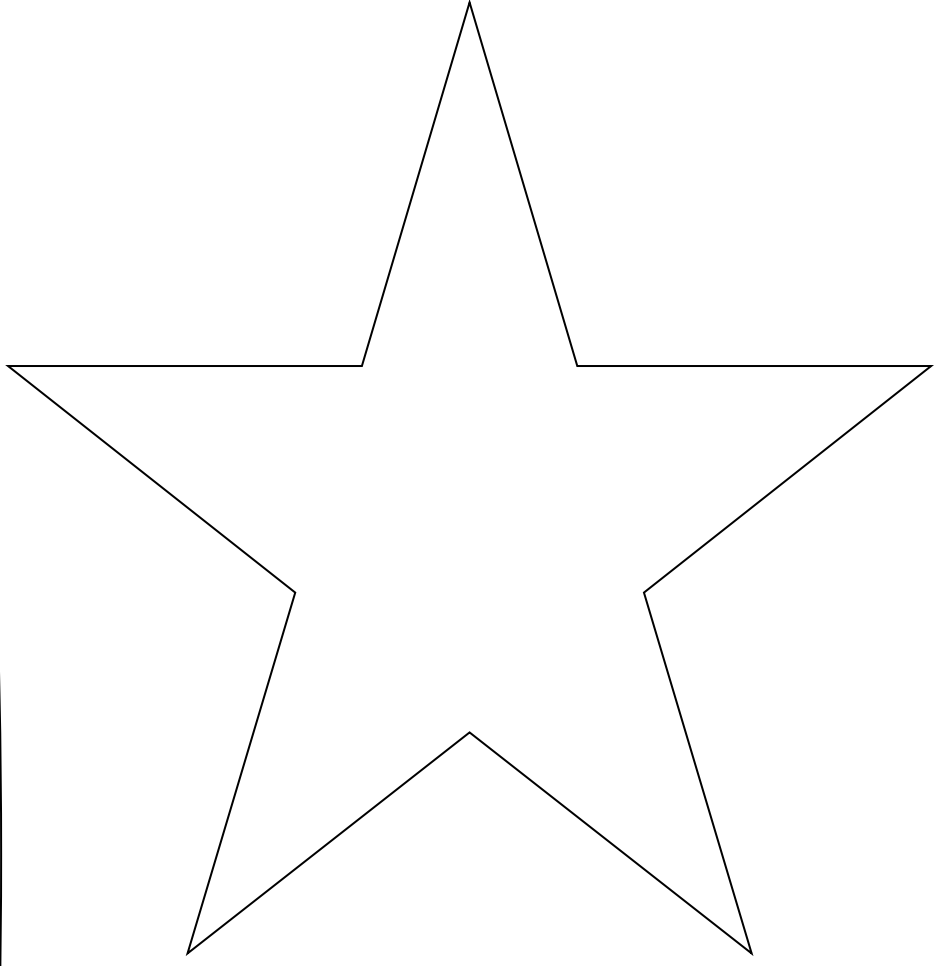
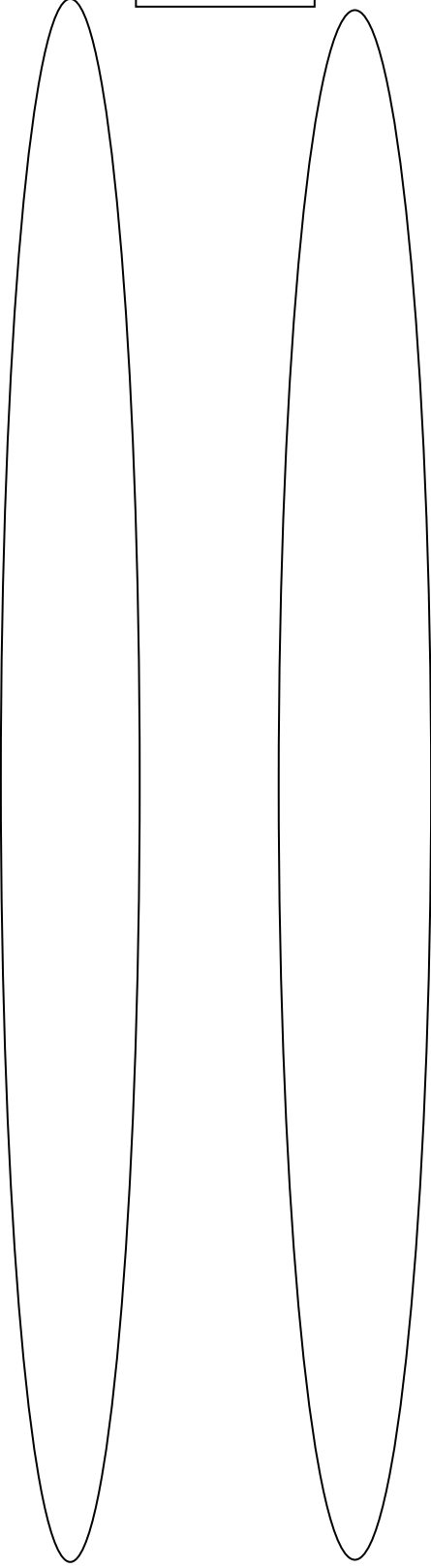
6. Colour in the star using either an orange or yellow felt tip, crayon or colouring pencil, or even paint it if you like.
7. Cut the leaves and the star out of the cardboard.
8. Glue trumpet to star.
9. Glue or staple leaves to the skewer (about 5cm from the base of the skewer).
10. Glue star to top of skewer.



Make as many as you like and fill vases or stick into flowerpots for instant flowers!

For those who are adventurous or do not have access to a printer – draw the leaves and star and colour in!
